If you have not been to St. Petersburg in recent years, you will be amazed at our vibrant downtown waterfront featuring many restaurants, shops, museums and parks. Those of you who attended the 55<sup>th</sup> will be surprised at the many new sights since then. There is even a new pier featuring several restaurants plus lots to see and do (check out <a href="www.stpetepier.org">www.stpetepier.org</a>) In addition to our world famous beaches, St. Petersburg is now an internationally acclaimed arts destination with two new world class museums, the James Museum of Western & Wildlife Art and the Museum of the American Arts and Crafts Movement, joining the Salvador Dali Museum, the Museum of Fine Arts and the Chihuly Collection. You can also visit the St. Petersburg Museum of History and the Florida Holocaust Museum. The SHINE St. Petersburg Mural Festival has graced our city with many outstanding murals, some in interesting out-of-the-way places.

St. Petersburg is also a culinary destination featuring a multitude of restaurants offering a wide diversity of cuisines in casual to luxury fine dining venues. It is recognized as the home of numerous outstanding craft microbreweries. You may want to take in our lively Saturday Morning Market, the largest one-day a week fresh market in the southeast located in the Al Lang Stadium parking lot; it offers a great eating experience as you browse the many vendors. Or you can enjoy a nostalgic visit to Sunken Gardens, now owned by the city; take the Dolphin Cruise along the downtown and residential waterfront; tour downtown St. Petersburg on the Looper trolley; or ride the ferry to Tampa and back. If you are a baseball fan, our exciting Tampa Bay Rays will be hosting the Boston Red Sox that weekend. The world famous "Sunshine City" that we grew up in has grown up also!
